The Candidate:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be aged 18-26</li> <li>• Must hold a minimum NVQ L2 or equivalent in hairdressing and/or barbering</li> <li>• Must be a State Registered Hairdresser/Barber (must apply if not an existing member)</li> </ul>
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The Role:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You will be expected to be responsive to e-mails</li> <li>• You will need to be available to attend 2 meetings per year in London (travel expenses can be reimbursed)</li> <li>• You will need to be available for 2 conference calls per year</li> </ul>
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Chair of the Junior Council	<p>A member of this group will need to stand as Chairman. The Chair will be expected to run the meeting with help from Ellie Agius at The Hair Council. This will involve working closely with Ellie on putting an agenda together for the meeting and making sure the meeting is run efficiently.</p> <p>The Chair will be offered a seat on the main Hair Council, where they will be expected to report the outcome of the Junior Council meetings to the committee.</p> <p>A Vice-Chair will also need to be elected. Their role will involve running a meeting if the Chair is unable to attend.</p>
