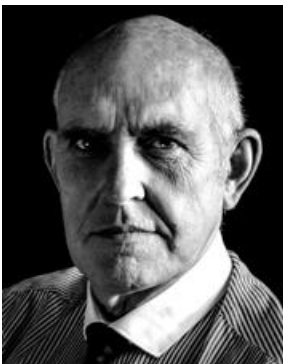

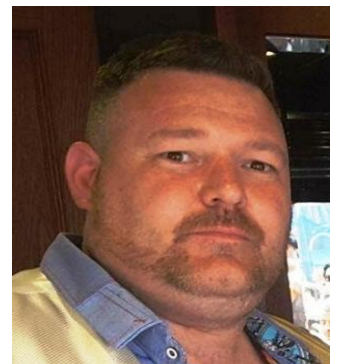

Rules for the UK Student of the Year Awards 2019

All competitors will be expected to submit two photographs of their work (front and side views) on a disc, USB stick (pendrive) or via email to sue@haircouncil.org.uk (Please see page 2 for closing dates). The model must be against a plain background and wearing a black top. The images should include one from the front and one from the side. The disk must have the nominees name, college or training centre and phone number written on the front (for USB sticks attach a sticker or tag) and images should be at least 800x1200 pixels. The images need to be clear and in focus, taken in a well-lit environment as poor-quality images may affect the judges' decisions.

The model chosen should reflect the image the competitor is trying to achieve. The competitor must be confident they can recreate the look within 45 minutes should they reach the final.

Level 2 – College Based

Competitors should create a classic men's look taking into account any influencing factors that may affect the finished result. Competitors will need to complete a full haircut including blow-dry and styling.

Apprenticeships or Level 3

Competitors should create a fashion look where they have pushed the boundaries and shown their creative mind and skill. Competitors will need to complete a full haircut including blow-dry and styling.

Competitors must be available on Monday the 7th of October to compete at Salon International, ExCel London, with their model, should they reach the final.
